After school classes and clubs are open to all students in the community from traditional, alternative and homeschools.

Micro:Coding Class – Wednesdays 3:15 – 4:45 p.m., April 3 – June 5

Students in grades 3-8 interested in going further with micro:bit can sign up for the after school micro:coding club.

Cost: \$200/student

American Sign Language Class – Wednesdays 3:15-4:45 p.m., April 3 – June 5

All skill levels are invited to learn conversational ASL vocabulary and phrases through flashcards, games, video interactions and activities. Appropriate for students grades 2 to adult.

Cost: \$250/student

Speed Cubing Club – Thursdays 6:00 – 7:00 p.m., weekly beginning April 6.

(Check website calendar for changes or updates.) Students in grades 3-9 can get together with others who enjoy solving mechanical puzzles, learn from each other and have fun.

Cost: \$5/student at the door

General Computer Skills for Adults– Mondays 4:30-5:30 p.m, April 1 – June 3 for Adults 18+

A basic course for adults and seniors who want to learn to secure a device from hackers, access internet, access email (including block junk mail), basic settings, accessibility settings, use of Bluetooth devices, basic video call use, and other questions students have.

Cost: \$175/student

Beginner Excel for Adults – Mondays 6:00-7:00 p.m, April 1 – June 3 for Adults 18+

An introductory look at Microsoft Excel for adults who feel it could be useful, felt overwhelmed trying to learn, and/or want to improve skills for work or other coursework. Course content includes how to make tables and add data, basic formatting, use formulas, print tables and charts, and more. *Requires a device with Excel. Contact us if you need help.

Cost: \$175/student
